

#### Local priorities

#### You said, we did:

**You said – Burglaries** Over the last few months we have received a number of reports of Burglaries around Weston Turville, Aston Clinton and Wendover.

**We did** –NHPT have carried out visibility patrols and have assisted investigations by conducting house to house enquiries. This includes scoping for CCTV/Ring door bell evidence.

In the coming weeks we will be looking to conduct some have your say meetings whereby we will offering suitable crime prevention advice and offering assistance with property marking.

We will be approaching that time of year whereby the neighbourhood team will generally focus on our winter time (leave a light on ) burglary campaign. The team will actively assess vulnerability to homes left in darkness and will offer suitable security advice.

**You said –Anti-social behaviour (ASB)** There have been numerous reports of late regarding anti-social behaviour and criminal damage occurring around the helicopter park in Princes Mary Gate (Wendover).

**We did** – The local NHPT team have been patrolling throughout the majority of their shifts and did conduct joint patrols with the RAF police. RAF are very much aware of the location and are also looking into target hardening. Patrols here will continue however the advice at the current time will be to ensure all valuables and anything of value is either taken out of the vehicles or kept out of sight.

If you have any concerns to report call 101 to make us aware (999 if an emergency).

**You said – Theft from Motor Vehicles.** Over the last few months the NHPT have received reports of suspicious activity around the Kingbrook, Wendover and Weston Turville area whereby individuals are either breaking into vehicles or acting suspiciously around them.

**We did** – The NHPT are actively carrying out visibility patrols around the area and will be carrying out such patrols up until the Christmas period. Please remain vigilant in accordance with your surroundings and if anyone is acting suspiciously then please call this in.

If you have any concerns or witness anything suspicious then again please call us on the 101 (non-emergency number) or 999.
